## PANCAKE RACE

## TUESDAY, 21 February 2023 Rules for Competitors Under 10's (6+)



- No child will be allowed to enter without a signed parental/guardian consent form which should be submitted to Lichfield City Council by <u>12 Noon on Friday 17 February 2023</u>
- 2. Parent/guardian must accompany entrants on the day.
- 3. All race entrants and accompanying adult must pre-register at Lichfield City Council Offices by <u>12 Noon on Friday 17 February 2023</u>
- All Race entrants must report to the Guildroom by 11.15am on the day prior to the start of the races.
  Competitors will not be allowed to register on the day.
- 5. Parents/guardians will take overall responsibility for their children's safety in ensuring that suitable non-slip footwear and suitable clothing is worn.
- Lichfield City Council reserves the right to refuse entry, places will be allocated strictly on a first come first served basis.
  Entrants who have not pre-registered will not be allowed to take part.
- 7. The race is for children under 10 years of age (Minimum age 6 years)
- 8. Runners will line up at the start and the Starter will declare: "Are you ready?" And then give the starting signal, at which point runners **MUST FLIP THE PANCAKE ONCE BEFORE SETTING OFF.**
- 9. Runners will run down Bore Street, with the pancake in the frying pan; flip the pancake once at the designated point before running to the finishing line.
- 10. At the finish the first runner across the line will be declared the winner.
- 11. In the event of a tie, the 2 runners will enter the final heat until one overall winner is declared.
- 12. Lichfield City Council reserves the right to cancel the races in adverse weather conditions and reserves the right to refuse entry.

## In the event of a dispute, the Mayor's decision is final.
