If you're seeking a venue that blends history, elegance, and modern amenities, the Grade II listed Guildhall in Lichfield is an ideal choice. Located in the heart of the city, this 600-year-old building offers a unique backdrop for your special celebration.

There are various rooms available to hire, including the impressive Main Hall, the more intimate Ashmole Room, the Guildroom and even the historic Prison Cells. All rooms on the first and second floor are accessible by lift.

Despite its historical significance, the Guildhall is equipped with modern amenities to ensure a seamless and comfortable experience for all your guests, whatever the occasion.

All rooms are charged at a competitive hourly rate; alternatively you may wish to book our Special Events package which allows exclusive use of the whole building (including the Old Prison Cells) for fifteen hours. Three rooms are licensed for Civil Ceremonies, making it ideal if you wish to hold your Wedding and reception in one location.

Guildhall Weddings

The Guildhall provides complete flexibility so you can create your own unique experience for a truly memorable and special day.

A selection of rooms are available to hire at a competitive hourly rate and can be set out as per your requirements. When set up banquet style the Main Hall has a maximum capacity of 130, however should you choose round tables then the maximum number of guests is 88.

A well-equipped bar is located in the Main Hall, which can be hired for an additional fee (minimum 4 hours, maximum 6 hours) and includes the provision of Security Industry Association (SIA) licensed security personnel.

Three rooms in the building are licensed for Civil Ceremonies and if you wish to use the Main Hall, it can easily be reset by our friendly Premises Attendants for a reception afterwards.

Being situated in the heart of Lichfield, you will be within walking distance of picturesque parks and gardens, perfect for capturing stunning Wedding photos. However, if the weather is unkind, the architectural features inside the building will ensure you can still create distinctive pictures of your special day.







Guildhall Concerts

The main Guildhall is an ideal concert venue with excellent acoustics.

It accommodates up to 195 people (theatre style) and includes bar services, making it a unique event space.

Guildroom

Ideal for smaller gatherings, the Guildroom has beautiful, panelled walls and a timber ceiling. This room is located on the ground floor and has a maximum capacity of 70.

There is a small adjoining kitchen making it ideal for a drinks reception or buffet. Alternatively, if you are having a Civil Ceremony in the Main Hall the room can be used by your guests whilst the upstairs is reset for the rest of your celebrations. This room is also licensed for Civil Ceremonies. The room can be utilised for meetings and presentations and the hire charge includes the use of a digital projector and screen.







Ashmole Room

The Ashmole room is situated between the first and second floors and tastefully decorated. This room is ideal for a small, intimate Civil Ceremony with a maximum capacity of 25.

It can also be used for small meetings and receptions. A digital projector and screen are included in the hire charge.

Tea and coffee can be provided for meetings for a maximum of 25 people.







Whytmore Room

Situated on the second floor, this room is light and airy with a maximum capacity of 25 and is ideal for small meetings. Alternatively, if hiring the whole building it can be used as a quiet room or dressing room.

The Whytmore room is also a designated prayer room.

The Old Prison Cells

The old prison cells are situated at the rear of the building and have been in existence since approximately 1545.

The cells, once the City lockup until the 1900s, reflect the city's history of law and order. The old police station gates can still be seen in the ground floor corridor.

Today, the cells can be utilised as a backdrop for photographs, adding a special touch to any occasion.
